



Dear friends and customers,

I'm writing to share some important news with you. After a great deal of thought and reflection, I've made the very difficult decision to close the bakery. **Our final day of operation will be January 31, 2026.** This was not an easy choice. This bakery has meant so much to me, and I am incredibly grateful for the support, kindness, and loyalty you have shown over these last few years. Creating and serving baked goods for you has brought me great joy.

I am especially thankful for the way you supported me through the transition from the previous owner — through your encouragement, kind words, wonderful Google reviews, frequent visits, and by recommending the bakery to your friends and family. Most recently, I was moved to tears by the support you showed during the electrical shutdown, when so many of you went out of your way to help ensure the baked goods didn't go to waste. All of these gestures have meant more to me than you probably realize. This decision comes down to long-term sustainability and my ability to continue running the business in a healthy way.

I'm not selling the business because I do hope to return to it someday — when the timing is right and I'm able to build it in a way that's more sustainable. In the meantime, I'm exploring the possibility of operating a much smaller, cottage (home-based) bakery focused on a handful of customer favorites. If I move forward with this idea, it would likely be shipping and delivery only within the state of Colorado (no pick-ups, due to HOA restrictions), with a minimum order of around \$35-\$40 and ideally a subscription-based model so I could plan production responsibly.

Before going any further, I want to understand whether there is genuine interest in something like this. This is not a commitment — just a way for me to learn whether I should continue to explore this idea. I would still love to be able to create delicious allergy-free baked goods for you on a smaller scale. Between now and January 31, we will continue operating as usual, and we would absolutely love to see you during this final month.
